Spanish Photography Workshops 2009

New for 2009, Mark Cargill Photography is delighted to launch a series of Spanish Photography Workshops. The program has been in the planning stages for over 12 months and is now ready for public consumption.

Based in the Murcia region of Spain, the workshops will be run over 7-days (6-nights) with 5-days tuition and Photography.

The hotels are only 10 minutes drive from San Javier Airport, which means very short transfer times for delegates arriving from abroad. There are a number of UK airlines flying directly to Murcia and those who book early can enjoy some very attractive prices. At time of writing it was possible to book a return flight (including taxes) for around £70!

Included in the pricing is all accommodation (with breakfast) and transfer costs to and from the airport.

"Having previously lived in the area, I knew that it was a brilliant location for photography" says Mark. "There are so many great opportunities around the Mar

Menor, that in reality you are spoilt for choice."

Transport is of the luxury variety with full air conditioning and room for 4 delegates.

"I am aware that there are only a few companies catering for such small groups (max of 4), however in most cases you will find yourself crammed into a 4x4, with 3 people across the back—not the most comfortable. We took the option of a proper luxury minibus to ensure that the journeys between locations are very comfortable indeed."
